**NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS**

**The Collaboration for Bridging and Organizing to Nurture and Develop  
Scientists (C-BONDS) (PD# 040201)**

The District Office has submitted a proposal for \$2,717,515 to the National  
Science Foundation for a five-year project which would involve 200 students  
in environmental chemistry research. The performance period for this project  
is from September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2009.

**Collaborative Research: Creating a Community College Undergraduate  
Research Center: Linking Chicago-Area Community Colleges with Four  
Year Institutions, National Labs and Industry (PD# 040202)**

Harold Washington College has submitted a proposal for \$428,701, in  
conjunction with a proposal from William Rainey Harper College (for  
\$2,271,895), to the National Science Foundation for a five year project which  
would create an undergraduate research center for college students in the  
Chicago area. The performance period for this project is from September 1,  
2004 through August 31, 2009.

**Illinois Community College System Educational Technology Grant (PD#  
040204)**

The City Colleges of Chicago has received an award of \$250,338 from the  
Illinois Community College Board for a project which will include staff  
development, technical/infrastructure improvement, online support or other  
expenditures approved in writing by ICCB. No purchasing, renting or leasing  
computer equipment and/or software will be allowed. Each college will  
receive \$35,760 (Kennedy-King will receive \$35,778). The performance  
period for this award is from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.

**GIFTS**

**1994 School Bus (PD# 040203g)**

Olive-Harvey College has received a gift of a 1994 School Bus from the Durham School Services of Evanston, Illinois. The bus is valued at approximately \$8,000.
