Women's Basketball Coach Selected to Assist U. S. National Team

REPORTS

that Kimberly McQuarter is one of the three coaches who have been selected to assist in the trial sessions of the 2004 USA Basketball Women's Junior National Team Trials at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado. McQuarter returns to USA Basketball after playing for the 1985 U.S. Olympic Festival North Team that won the bronze medal; and

that McQuarter piloted the 2002-03 Malcolm X College squad to a 24-9 record and a No. 1 finish in our conference, district and region. McQuarter was honored as the district and conference Coach of the Year for her efforts. Starting off the 2003-04 season with a NJCAA No. 21 ranking, her squad was ranked as high as 15th in the nation during a season, which saw her post, a 25-6 record. She again claimed the district and conference championship, as well as conference Coach of the Year honors; and

that as four-year letter winner (1985-86 through 1988-89) and two-year starter at Old Dominion University (Va.), McQuarter helped the Monarchs to a trio of NCAA Tournaments, including the 1987 Sweet Sixteen, as well as the 1987 Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship. Named to the 1989 All-Sun Belt second team, McQuarter assisted ODU to a 73-47 record and was ranked 19th in the nation after compiling 1,274 career points
