Honors More than 100 Students for Scholarship, Service

**REPORTS** At the Wright College Student Government Association Honors/Activities Awards Program May 2, more than 100 students were honored for scholarship and service. Seven students had earned 4.0 grade averages and received scholarships. Another 16 were honored for having earned a grade point average of 3.85 or higher.

Four students were honored for outstanding contributions and excellence in English and literature; four were honored by the humanities department. The physical science department honored five and the math department honored six. The social science department recognized eight students with scholarships; one student from the speech Department was honored.

A Stage Wright Thesbian Award was presented to six students for outstanding achievement in theater classes. Three students received awards for their outstanding leadership in the student newspaper, *Diversity*, and 13 received meritorious certificates for excellent participation on the newspaper staff. Fifteen students were recognized for leadership in other student organizations. Two were honored from the Future Teachers of Chicago and eight from the Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers. In addition nine students, officers of the Theta Omega Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society, were honored for having excelled in promoting academic excellence and superior leadership through the year.

Eleven students received \$250 scholarships from the Chicago City College Teachers' Union, Local 1600. Three students received monetary awards from the Illinois Community Colleges Trustees Association, having written essays. Monetary prizes of \$100, \$75 and \$50 were awarded to the students respectively.
