**Wright College's Project Graduation Feeding Bodies and Minds  
One Book and One Can of Food at a Time**

**REPORTS** Project Graduation, an initiative of the Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society for two-year colleges continues to alleviate hunger and illiteracy in the community. At Wright College's 2003 commencement ceremony, the Theta Omega Chapter at Wright College collected 2,015 books and 1,866 pounds of food. These books were donated to Harriet Beecher Stowe elementary school. All 1,866 pounds of food were donated to the Greater Chicago Food Depository.

Project Graduation for the 2004 –2005 year was kicked off at the commencement ceremony on May 8, 2004. So far, 923 books have been collected along with 540 nonperishable food items. Four hundred and sixty-three of these books have been given to Harriet Beecher Stowe elementary school, while the rest will be given to Vaughn High School. The 540 food items have been donated to the Irving Park Community Food Pantry.

Collection of food and books is still ongoing.
