that the Wright College Environmental Technology Program on January 30, 2004 hosted an informational workshop for gas station owners through out the Chicagoland area. Over 100 participants attended the meeting sponsored by the City of Chicago Department of the Environment, the Illinois EPA and the U.S. EPA. The featured speaker at the meeting was City of Chicago Department of the Environment Deputy Commissioner for Permitting and Enforcement, Ms. Maggie Rice.

The purpose of the Workshop was to help gas station owners understand regulations regarding the management of their underground storage tanks. These regulations are intended to prevent underground gasoline storage tanks from leaking so they do not contaminate Chicago's soil and water.

We also will continue to serve as the environmental training provider for the staff of the City of Chicago Department of the Environment.
