that the Wright College Environmental Technology Program, with Board approval, will enter into an Alliance with the U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration, Chicago North Area OSHA Office. This Alliance is intended to provide support to the clients of the ETP Business and Industry Services program.

Once approved by the Board of Trustees of District 508 and its General Counsel, OSHA and the ETP would work together to achieve the following outreach and communication goals:

- Develop and disseminate OSHA Strategic Management Plan (SMP) information through print and electronic media, including electronic tools and links from OSHA's and ETP's Web sites along with applicable articles in their print media
- Speak, exhibit, or appear at conferences of business or labor-focused events sponsored by the ETP to provide a forum for OSHA personnel to participate
- Promote and encourage stakeholders associated with the ETP to participate in OSHA's compliance assistance, education and outreach programs

OSHA's Alliances provide parties an opportunity to participate in a voluntary cooperative relationship with OSHA for purposes of education, training and outreach to promote a dialogue on workplace safety and health. This Alliance would benefit the ETP program and its clients by making the most current OSHA materials and services available through Wilbur Wright College.
